First Things First...

But I see four men unbound, walking in the midst of the fire, and they are not hurt, and the appearance of the fourth is like a son of God. Daniel 3:25

The context

Occasionally, we might see something that seems out of place or too spectacular to be true or that we simply do not understand. Eyes may widen as the jaw drops, the eyes may blink repeatedly or we may rub them with our hand; somehow, an attempt is made to make sense of a nonsensical sight. King Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon may have done those things when he looked into the fiery furnace he had built to punish those who refused to worship his golden image. Into that conflagration three Hebrew men would supposedly meet their doom. Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego refused to bow down to the golden idol the king had cast to honor himself. In anger the King ordered fire seven times hotter than the design specifications. The flames were so severe that the soldiers pushing their captives into the flames perished from the intense heat. As the Hebrews fell into the flames the king leaped to his feet in amazement asking, "Weren't there three men that we tied up and cast into the flames?" Those with him answered, "Certainly, O King." The King replied, "But I see four men unbound, walking in the midst of the fire, and they are not hurt, and the appearance of the fourth is like a son of God." While the bonds were incinerated, the clothing they wore was not singed. Such was their protection that when they walked out of the furnace, their clothing did not even carry the smell of smoke. Nebuchadnezzar realized the fourth man in the flames was the God of Israel, and the King declared, "no other God can save in this way."


The current "fire"

All the news media (true, fake, legacy, real or name it as you will...) clamor reveals the world as being on the brink of war. Ukraine/Russia, Congo/Rwanda, Ethiopia/Egypt, Gaza/Israel/Iran, India/Pakistan, +16 other wars provide sufficient evidence for the signs of the apocalyptic prophecies in Matthew 24:6 and Mark 13:7, you shall hear of wars and rumors of wars. Even without armed, military conflict the headlines scream about anarchy in cities featuring riots, looting, vandalism, acts of arson, and lawlessness. The spread of nuclear weaponry could initiate a worldwide "furnace" consuming most or all of life.

Their Deliverer (and ours)

Those three young men in Daniel chapter 3, presented their faith to King Nebuchadnezzar saying, "Our God is able to deliver us, but if He doesn't, it's all the same. We will not worship any other God (my paraphrase)." It was a pre-Incarnate visitation of Christ that protected the faithful men thrown into the Babylonian furnace. We may not face a fiery furnace, but we do face "heat" in our lives. We are reminded that we go through "fiery" trials to test our faith, to remove the dross of the old Adam clinging to us, and the refinement of the gold of Christ within us (James 1:3; 1 Peter 1:6-7). Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego experienced the personal presence of the Savior, and he delivered them from danger and harm. We have the promise of Jesus, "I am with you always," and "I will never leave you nor forsake you" (Matthew 28:20; Hebrews 13:5). In the hymn, How Firm a Foundation, J. Rippon wrote: When through fiery trials your pathway shall lie; My grace, all sufficient, shall be your supply. The flames shall not hurt you; I only design your dross to consume and your gold to refine. We stand in our faith in the fire!




