First Things First...

So, to keep me from becoming conceited because of the surpassing greatness of the revelations, a thorn was given me in the flesh, a messenger of Satan to harass me, to keep me from becoming conceited. Three times I pleaded with the Lord about this, that it should leave me. But He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness."

2 Corinthians 12:7-9a

There was a time when the lesson offered through Paul's words was succinctly stated by many parents saying, "You're getting a little too big for your britches." Paul's supplication is couched in humility 'I pleaded with the Lord...." However, for us it is so easy to cross the line between humility and vanity. In praying relief or release from some difficulty life presents, our words harbor a hidden touch of egotism: I deserve this, Lord, so give it to me" or "I don't deserve this, Lord, so take it from me" or "Why, Lord?" The truth is we deserve nothing good and often earn anything bad that comes our way. Nor does God owe us an explanation for anything He does or doesn't do. We have no recourse except the love God poured out for us on Calvary's cross. Our Heavenly Father said to Paul and says to us, "My grace is sufficient for you..." If we receive nothing from God but His forgiveness, it is enough.

The apostle learned two lessons through his "thorn...in the flesh." Those were:

- 1) to keep (Paul and us) from becoming conceited, and
- 2) God's power is made perfect in (Paul's and our) weakness.

Every experience of our lives offers lessons from our Heavenly Father and conveys His love for us. His thoughts and ways and plans are far beyond our comprehension and understanding (cf. Isaiah 55:8-9). Yet, His promise to us is: "And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to His purpose." (Romans 8: 28) We are wise to remember the words of the popular song:

When peace like a river attendeth my way, when sorrows like sea billows roll; whatever my lot Thou hast taught me to say, "It is well, it is well with my soul.¹



First School And Day Care

The First School is proud to announce that we received a grant from the Bouligny Charitable Foundation!


The grant is in the amount of \$16,747.15 for a new 25' X 45' basketball court for our school age kids, a 345 sq ft concrete walkway to extend from the kitchen door to the Johnson House, and a fence for a playground for our infants in the parsonage. The fence will be 90 ft (3, 30 foot sections) of 4-foot-tall ornamental with a 5-foot-wide gate. It will be done by J4 Fencing and will match our other black playground gate that was recently installed by them.

The concrete work for our walkway and basketball court will be done by Lonestar Concrete.

The contracts are signed and we are just waiting in line for the contractors to get to us.

We are excited to have these new additions to our campus as they are much needed!


